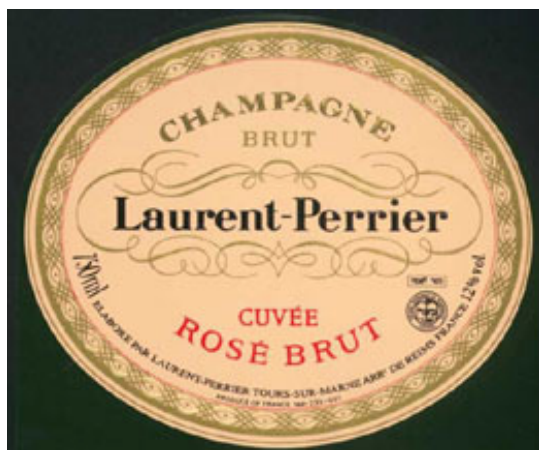

Champagne

Champagne is the undisputed king of Sparkling wine. The wines have been made in almost exactly the same fashion for generations, since the Monk, Dom Pierre Pérignon discovered the importance of blending wines from around the region and in turn putting them in stronger bottles to aid the secondary fermentation process. Commercial wine production in the Champagne region has been ongoing since 1729, when the house of Ruinart became the first to sell sparkling wine. Since then, countless others have followed. The production process was further refined in the early 1800's by the Veuve Clicquot, who devised a method of removing the sediment from the bottles without compromising the fizz. Champagne was from then on, as we know it today; a fine clear sparkling wine.

Burgundy White



Burgundy is an area rich in history, gastronomy and wine. Unlike the great estates of Bordeaux, the finest Burgundian vineyards are owned by a proliferation of smallholders, a direct result of the revolution. Prior to 1789 the church owned most of the vineyards in Burgundy but these were seized and broken up, the new order being

as much anti-church as anti-aristocracy.

The wines of Burgundy show the relevance of the influence of terrior to the finished product. As all wines grown in Burgundy come from just four grape varieties it is amazing to note the subtle differences from one commune to the next.

Alsace White



Situated in the shadow of the Voges Mountains, along the German border, Alsace is in fact the sunniest wine region in France.

The wines of Alsace are particularly unique in that they are the only region in France to use the grape variety on the label.

Alsace winemakers use Germanic grape varieties such as Gewurztraminer and Riesling, but produce wines with a typical French style.

The wines produced range in style from bone dry to lusciously sweet.

Loire Valley White



The Loire is the longest river in France. From its source in the Cévennes mountains, it runs due west for just over one thousand kilometres to the ocean at Nantes. As a result, the variations in soil, climate and grape varieties found along its banks and those of its tributaries are reflected in the wide range of wines grown in this region.

Rhone Valley White



Stretching from Vienne to Avignon, the Côtes du Rhône is around two hundred Kilometres in length. It is split into two distinct parts. The Northern Rhône is famous for the white wines of Condrieu and Château Grillet, both made from Viognier and the red wines of Hermitage and Côte Rôtie, which are made from Syrah.

In the South, the style of wine changes completely, with white wines becoming somewhat of a rarity. Big robust full-bodied red wines are the staple of the southern Rhône, with Gigondas and Châteauneuf du pape being the most famous examples. Here in the south, Grenache is the dominant grape variety.

Bordeaux Red



Red Bordeaux is elegant, having a firm but feminine style, the finest wine of its kind in the world, but its characteristic softness and subtlety come only with bottle age. Although initially quite heavy in tannin and sturdy in youth, the wines mature beautifully and later attain a softness and elegance.

The wines of Bordeaux are influenced greatly by its proximity to water. The wines of the Médoc and Graves are directly influenced by the Atlantic ocean to the west and on their eastern border, the river Garonne, a tributary of the River Gironde. Here the dominant Grape variety is Cabernet Sauvignon. On the right bank of the Gironde, where it merges with the river Dordogne, lie the communes of St. Emilion and Pomerol, where Merlot is Dominant.

Most white Bordeaux comes from the area between the two tributaries of the Gironde, known as Enter-Deux-Mers.
